The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will host design public hearings for the public to review and provide comments on the preliminary design plans and the findings of the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Transform 66 Inside the Beltway Eastbound Widening Project. The EA is being prepared in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended, and 23 CFR Part 771. Pursuant to Section 6009 of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act – A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) and 23 CFR Part 774 (Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) intends to make a Section 4(f) *de minimis* finding related to anticipated impacts of the project on Section 4(f) resources, which include parks, trails, and historic properties. In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information on potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is included in the environmental document. VDOT is evaluating capacity improvements to reduce congestion along a four-mile stretch of Interstate 66 inside the Beltway from the Dulles Connector Road to Fairfax Drive (Exit 71).
